HEALTH AND VITALITY

Worldwide, living conditions in refugee camps and displacement centres, are dire.

Coronavirus is making this even worse - in congestd camps, it's almost impossible to socially distance. Water and soap are rare luxuries, and basic household items, vital for health and safety, are scarce.

By providing families with handwash basins and soap, they are able to maintain good hygiene and keep themselves protected.





PROTECTION FROM DISEASE

Refugee communities are often left vulnerable to deadly diseases like malaria.

That's why we send mosquito nets to areas of the world where malaria, zika, and other mosquito spread diseases are prevalent.

Each net is treated to keep mosquitoes away, providing families with a safe place to eat, sleep and live.





LIGHT IN THE DARKNESS

When refugees flee their homes, they are stripped away from light and comfort. That's why all our aid packages include LuminAid solar lanterns.

Able to last up to 16 hours on just one charge, these lights are lightweight and can float in water, making them easy to carry in any situation. They illuminate dark and dangerous paths and help create safe environments where people can pick up their daily routine.





CLEAN WATER

When refugees are far from home, it can be hard to access safe, clean water.

That's exactly why we provide families with water filters and water carriers - so that safe drinking water can become one less thing to worry about.

Our filters can turn up to 1000 litres of unsafe water into clean drinking water, by removing viruses, bacteria, pathogens, chemicals, heavy metals, and fecal matter.





WARMTH AND PROTECTION

When refugees flee their homes, they often leave everything behind - forcing them to face cold nights with no access to blankets or other sources of warmth.

That's why we include thermal blankets in our aid packages - to provide refugees with a sense of warmth and comfort during the winter.

"Usually to cover us, we used sail cloths or pieces of loin cloth. Now we will use these beautiful blankets".





TOOLS TO REBUILD

When families flee, they lose their homes, possessions and livelihoods.

ShelterBox's ShelterKits are equipped with a hammer, saw, rope, pliers, and an assortment of other tools that enable families to rebuild.

"I grow millet, groundnuts and maize. I work with a hoe, machete and rake. Making do with what I have".





HEART OF THE HOME

Family meals help to provide the framework of everyday life.

But, most refugees don't have access to their own cooking equipment.

By providing cooking sets, containing a range of sturdy utensils, families can spend quality time together, cooking and eating meals that provide normality and nourishment.





A SAFE PLACE TO CALL HOME

When families flee their homes, they often travel for several days, by foot, on the hunt for a place of refuge - sleeping wherever they can along the way.

By providing family-sized tents in our aid packages, families are able to have somewhere safe to sleep, live, and begin their long journey to recovery.

"With the tent, everything became comfortable - sleep, daily life and cooking. *Life is now possible".*
