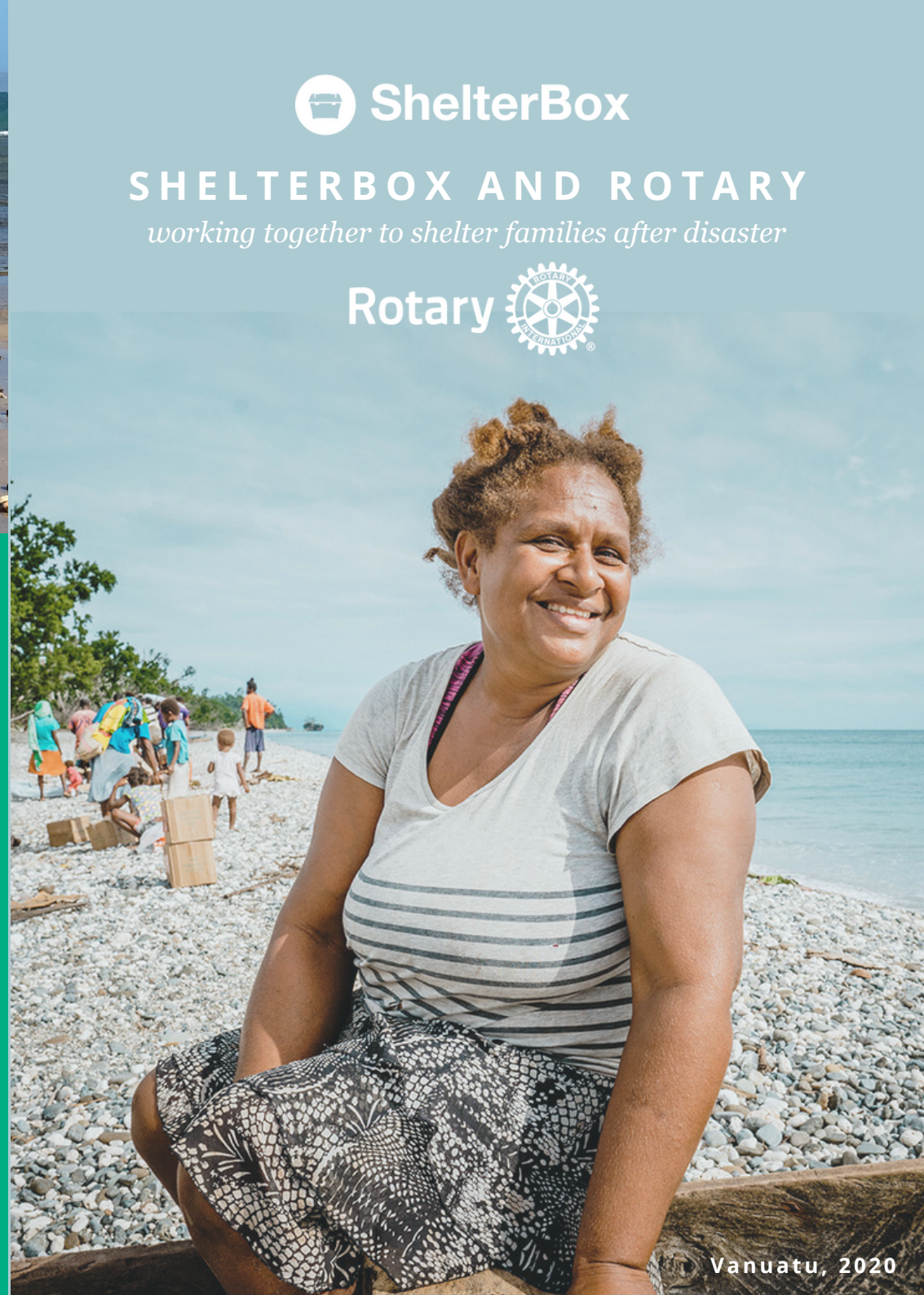
PEOPLE OF ACTION

WELCOME TO SHELTERBOX NEW ZEALAND

ShelterBox is an international disaster relief charity that hand-delivers emergency shelter and essential aid items, to people worldwide, to help them rebuild, following weather-related disasters and conflict.

On average, only 1 in 5 people receive the emergency shelter they need following a disaster. Not all disasters make the news, but all of them devastate people's lives.

Recovery starts with shelter. Having somewhere dry and warm to sleep, to prepare meals and be with your community, is vital for starting the long process of recovery.

Every disaster is different. This is why we have a flexible approach. We listen and learn from the communities we work alongside to provide them with the right tools to self-recover.



SHELTERBOX AND ROTARY IN ACTION

When ShelterBox and Rotary work together after disasters, the combination of ShelterBox's technical expertise and Rotary's community connections means that families are given the best tools and support they need to quickly start their process of recovery.

Following Tropical Storm Usman, ShelterBox deployed teams to support families who had lost their homes. On arrival, the team met with a local Rotarian, who set up meetings with Rotary clubs in the worst affected areas.
