Earthquakes. Hurricanes. Floods. Every year, thousands of families see their homes destroyed in a matter of minutes. In the wake of a disaster, families often need to make immediate repairs to their damaged homes.

Our ShelterKits contain a selection of tools, that can be used to make emergency shelters, repair damaged buildings and create the foundations for new homes, immediately after a disaster.

We customise these kits to suit the location and the needs of each community. Sometimes they include corrugated iron to help make resilient roofing, or even room dividers and mattresses to make warehouses habitable – whatever it takes to help people recover from disaster.

Depending on the situation, we often add other essentials items, including solar lights, mattresses and water containers, to help people return to normality as soon as possible.

A ShelterKit may include:



Rope:

this universal essential can make shelters secure and stable



Shovel:

to prepare foundations for a shelter or dig drainage ditches



Tarpaulin:

to create walls and roofs



Hammer:

to help nail together a home
